Applied Research and Development (ARDP) Program Award

The team of investigators, including Yoosook Lee, Lindsay Campbell, Brian Byrd, Benjamin Allen, and Dan Killingsworth, received funding from USDA to test various CDC light traps and lure configurations to enhance the biodiversity of mosquito collections. Dr. Joseph LaForest from Southern IPM Center suggested pursuing this funding after he learned about our program. We were able to get this funding on the first try because of having you as a member of the BEACONS, a solid network for extension, data generated from capacity surveys providing strong justification, and our past success with the southern IPM Center and
